OAPABA Board Member Beth Bagley Elected to Deschutes County Circuit Court

Oregon Asian Pacific American Bar Association (OAPABA) is pleased to announce the election of OAPABA board member Beth Bagley to the Deschutes County Circuit Court this past November. Ms. Bagley is the first elected Asian Pacific American judge and the first APA woman to take the bench in Deschutes County history.

Ms. Bagley has a distinguished career as a prosecutor and has served with the Deschutes County District Attorney's Office for over 10 years. She received her Doctor of Jurisprudence degree, *cum laude*, from the University of Minnesota Law School. Ms. Bagley also received her Bachelor of Arts in Political Science and a Bachelor of Arts in Latin American Studies, with High Honors, *Phi Beta Kappa*, from University of California, Santa Barbara.

Since the start of her legal career, Ms. Bagley has demonstrated an unyielding commitment to public service and has been actively involved in professional and community associations. She is a long-time OAPABA member and is serving her second term on the OAPABA Board. In addition to being an OAPABA board member, Ms. Bagley is a member of the Oregon Women Lawyers, Oregon State Bar Local Professional Responsibility Committee, Bend-La Pine School District, and J.R. Campbell Inns of Court.

OAPABA proudly endorsed Beth Bagley in her bid for the Deschutes County Circuit Court and remains confident that she will continue to excel in serving the State of Oregon and her community as a circuit court judge.
